On the Light Side

Cream Ale sample 2⁰⁰ pint 6⁰⁰

TAPS Fish House & Brewery, Brea, CA

Light American Ale. Light in body and color, smooth, and very drinkable. Enjoy if you like a Blonde. (5.5% abv)

Prima Pils sample 2⁰⁰ pint 6⁰⁰

Victory Brewing Co., Downingtown, PA

German-Style Pilsner. A light-bodied pale golden lager with an herbal hop character and slightly dry finish. (5.3% abv)

Hoegaarden sample 2⁰⁰ pint 6⁰⁰

De Kluis Brewery, Hoegaarden, Belgium

Belgian White Beer. This light-bodied, Belgian wheat ale is spiced with coriander and orange peels. Hints of citrus with a pleasantly crisp finish. Enjoy if you like Blue Moon. (5% abv)

Bud Light sample 2⁰⁰ pint 6⁰⁰

St. Louis, MO

American Light Lager. (4.2% abv)

On the Malty Side

Irish Red sample 2⁰⁰ pint 6⁰⁰

TAPS Fish House & Brewery, Brea, CA

Irish-Style Red Ale. Medium-bodied with exceptional balance. Slightly toasty and easy to drink with a hint of caramel on the finish. Enjoy if you like Newcastle Brown Ale. (5.6% abv)

Marzen sample 2⁰⁰ pint 6⁰⁰

Sudwerk Brewing Co., Davis, CA

German-Style Marzen. A medium-bodied, copper colored German-style lager, a bit caramelly with a malty, smooth finish. Enjoy if you like Sam Adams Boston Lager. (5.3% abv)

Maudite sample 3⁰⁰ tulip 7⁰⁰

Unibroue, Quebec, Canada

Belgian-Style Strong Dark Ale. A medium to full-bodied, mahogany colored ale with some light spices in the nose and hints of dark fruit throughout with a crisp, balanced finish. (8% abv)



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On the Malty Side (cont.)

Black Phoenix sample 2⁰⁰ pint 6⁰⁰

Bootlegger's Brewery, Fullerton, CA

Chipotle Coffee Stout. A very full-bodied American ale, dark as night and brewed with freshly roasted coffee and chipotle peppers. Great on its own or with dessert. (6.7% abv)

Angel Share sample 3⁰⁰ tulip 9⁰⁰

The Lost Abbey, San Marcos, CA

Barrel-Aged American Strong Ale. Full-bodied, dark brown in color, with rich flavors of vanilla and caramel from the time spent in oak. Finish is long and lingering with a touch of sweetness. (12.5%)

On the Yeasty/Spicy Side

Hefeweizen sample 2⁰⁰ pint 6⁰⁰

TAPS Fish House & Brewery, Brea, CA

German-Style Unfiltered Wheat Beer. A classic Bavarian-style, copper in color, light to medium in body, with hints of banana and clove from the authentic German yeast strain. A slight sweetness with a long smooth finish. Better without a lemon. Enjoy if you like Franziskaner. (5.3% abv)

Saison Dupont sample 3⁰⁰ tulip 8⁰⁰

Brasserie Dupont, West-Hainaut, Belgium

Belgian Farmhouse Ale. A very drinkable ale that pairs well with almost anything. Medium in body, golden in color, a bit spicy, with a pleasantly dry, crisp finish. (6.5% abv)

Duvel Green sample 3⁰⁰ tulip 8⁰⁰

Moortgat Brewery, Breendonk, Belgium

Belgian Golden Ale. A light-bodied ale, pale blonde in color with a mild, herbal hop character in the nose and subtle citrus on the palate, finishing dry and refreshing. A slightly lighter, draft only version of the classic original. (6.8% abv)

Mischief sample 3⁰⁰ 11.5 oz. tulip 7⁰⁰

The Bruery, Placentia, CA

Hoppy Belgian-Style Golden Strong Ale. Light to medium in body, with bright citrus in the nose and hints of pear, ripe melon, and peppery spice with a crisp, dry finish. (8.5% abv)

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On the Yeasty/Spicy Side (cont.)

Bishop's Trippel sample 2⁰⁰ tulip 6⁰⁰

Main St Brewery, Corona, CA

Belgian-Style Tripel. Beautiful golden color, full-bodied, spicy, nice and fruity, with a slightly dry finish. (9.5%)

On the Hoppy Side

Barleywine sample 2⁰⁰ tulip 7⁰⁰

TAPS Fish House & Brewery, Brea, CA

English-Style Barleywine. A rich, mahogany colored English-style unfiltered dark ale. Very full-bodied, hints of dark fruit, toffee, and caramel with a very assertively dry finish. (10.0% abv)

Poppyfields Pale Ale sample 2⁰⁰ pint 6⁰⁰

Craftsmen, Pasadena, CA

English-Style Pale Ale. A medium-bodied amber ale. A bit fruity with a subtle hop character balanced by a malty finish. Enjoy if you like Fat Tire. (4.9% abv)

Union Jack IPA sample 2⁰⁰ pint 6⁰⁰

Firestone Walker, Paso Robles, CA

American India Pale Ale. A medium-bodied amber ale with hints of citrus and pineapple with an assertively, dry and hoppy finish. (7.5% abv)

Oaked Arrogant Bastard sample 2⁰⁰ pint 6⁰⁰

Stone Brewing Co., Escondido, CA

American Strong Ale. A medium bodied, reddish-brown ale, with a bit of fruit and a dry, slightly tannic finish. (7.2% abv)

On the Sour/Tart Side

Oude Tart sample 3⁰⁰ 11.5 oz. tulip 8⁰⁰

The Bruery, Placentia, CA

Flemish-Style Red Ale. Light to medium in body, pleasantly sour with hints of sweet cherries, toasty oak, and a touch of leather. Finish is complex and acidic. Aged in red wine barrels for 18 months. A rare beer to come by, sip and savor! (7.5% abv)

BOTTLES

On the Malty Side

Chimay Grande Reserve “Blue” 11.2 oz 8⁰⁰

Bieres de Chimay, Belgium

Dark Belgian Strong. A classic Trappist ale. Deep brownish in color, full-bodied, with hints of caramel, dark fruit, and raisins with a slightly spicy finish. (9.0% abv)

Ten Fidy 12 oz 7⁰⁰

Oscar Blues Brewery, Lyons, CO

American Imperial Stout. A black, full-bodied ale with layers of milk chocolate and dark roasted coffee followed by a slightly sweet, malty finish. (10.5%)

Adam 12 oz 9⁰⁰

Hair of the Dog Brewing Company, Portland, OR

American Strong Ale. A truly unique dark American Ale. Very full-bodied, deep mahogany in color, with rich layers of sweet fig and leather, finishing malty and complex but nicely balanced. (10% abv)

Rochefort 10, “Blue Cap” 11.2 oz 10⁰⁰

Abbaye St-Remy, Rochefort, Belgium

Belgian Quadruple. A full-bodied, deep mahogany Trappist ale with rich flavors of dark fruit and port wine on the finish. Very complex. (11.3% abv)

On the Yeasty/Spicy Side

Westmalle Trappist Tripel 11.2 oz 9⁰⁰

Brouwerij Westmalle, Belgium

Belgian Tripel. This medium-bodied golden ale is the benchmark for the Belgian Tripel Style. Beautifully balanced with hints of tropical fruit and a slightly dry finish. (9.5% abv)

Orval Trappist Ale 11.2 oz 8⁰⁰

Brasserie d’Orval, Florenville, Belgium

Belgian Pale Ale. A world class Trappist ale. Light to medium in body, copper in color, with an earthy, slightly acidic bouquet and long, dry finish. (6.9% abv)

On the Hopy Side

Barleywine 22 oz 9⁰⁰

Green Flash Brewing Co. Vista, CA

American Barleywine. A West Coast version of a classic style. Loaded with American hops, full bodied, layers of sweet toffee and rich caramel with a very assertive dry finish. (10.9% abv)

On the Sour/Tart Side

La Roja 25.4 oz 16⁰⁰

Jolly Pumpkin Artisan Ales. Dexter, MI

Flanders-Style Amber Ale. A light to medium-bodied barrel-aged artisan ale. Hints of earth, caramel, and sour fruit with a long, dry, tart finish. (7.2%)

On the Sweet Side

Framboise 11.2 oz 7⁰⁰

Brouwerij Lindemans. Vlezenbeek, Belgium

Raspberry Lambic. A medium-bodied, reddish colored fruit beer packed with sweet raspberries. Great on its own or with chocolate.
